Unpack the machine and check the components

- The components included in the box may differ depending on your country.
- · We recommend that you save the original packaging.
- If for any reason you must ship your machine, carefully repack the machine in the original packaging to avoid any damage during transit. The machine should be adequately insured with the carrier. For how to repack the machine, see Packing and shipping the machine in the User's
- Illustrations in this Quick Setup Guide are based on the HL-5450DN.
- To ensure safe operation the supplied plug must be inserted only into a standard power outlet that is properly grounded through the standard electrical wiring. Non grounded equipment may cause an electrical shock hazard, and may cause excessive electrical noise radiation.
- The interface cable is not a standard accessory. Buy the appropriate interface cable for the connection you want to use (parallel (HL-5440D and HL-5445D only) or Network (HL-5450DN

USB cable

It is recommended to use a USB 2.0 (Type A/B) interface cable that is no longer than 2 meters. Parallel cable (HL-5440D and HL-5445D only)

- DO NOT use a parallel interface cable that is longer than 2 meters. Use a shielded interface cable that is IEEE 1284-compliant.
- Network cable (HL-5450DN only)
- Use a straight-through Category 5 (or greater) twisted-pair cable for 10BASE-T or 100BASE-TX






Remove the packing material from the machine

- Remove the packing tape from the outside of the machine.
- **D.** Open the MP tray **1**, and remove the packing tape **2** from the MP tray support, then close the MP tray.




C. Press the front cover release button and open the front cover. Remove the silica gel pack 1.




DO NOT eat the silica gel pack. Please throw away. If ingested, seek medical attention

e. Remove the orange protective material from the drum unit and toner cartridge assembly.



g. Put the drum unit and toner cartridge assembly firmly back in the machine. **h.** Close the front cover of the machine.








Load paper in the paper tray


- **a.** Pull the paper tray completely out of the machine.
- **D.** While pressing the green paper-guide release lever **1**, slide the paper guides to fit the paper size you are loading in the tray. Make sure that the guides are firmly in the slots.




- **C.** Fan the stack of paper well to avoid paper jams and misfeeds.
- **d.** Put the paper in the tray and make sure:
- The paper is below the maximum paper mark (▼▼▼) ①. Over filling the paper tray will cause paper jams.



e. Put the paper tray firmly back in the machine. Make sure that it is completely inserted into the machine.



Lift up the support flap 1 to prevent paper from sliding off the face-down

Web Based Management (web browser)

The Brother print server is equipped with a web server that allows you to monitor its status or change some of its configuration settings, using HTTP (Hyper Text Transfer

We recommend Windows® Internet Explorer® 7.0/8.0 or Firefox® 3.6 for Windows® and Safari 4.0/5.0 for Macintosh. Please also make sure that JavaScript and Cookies are always enabled in whichever browser you use. To use a web browser, you will need to know the IP Address of the print server. The IP Address of the print server is listed on the Printer Settings

a. Open your browser.

b. Type "http://machine's IP address/" into your browser's address bar (where "machine's IP address" is the IP address of the Brother machine or the print server

■ For example: http://192.168.1.2/

If you have configured an optional login password, you must enter it when prompted to access the Web Based Management.

Reset the network settings to the factory default

You can reset the print server back to its default factory settings (resetting all information such as the password and IP address information).

- **a.** Turn off the machine.
- **b.** Make sure that the front cover is closed and the power cord is plugged in.
- C. Hold down Go as you turn on the power switch. Keep Go pressed down until all the LEDs light up and then Ready LED turns off.
- d. Release Go. Make sure that all the LEDs turn off.
- e. Press Go six times. Make sure that all the LEDs light up to indicate the print server has been reset to its factory default settings. The machine will restart.

Print the Printer Settings Page

The Printer Settings Page lists all the current printer settings, including network

- **a.** Make sure that the front cover is closed and the power cord is plugged in.
- **b.** Turn on the machine and wait until the machine is in the Ready state. **C.** Press **Go** three times within 2 seconds. The machine will print the current printer settings page.
